Project Description

Nelson & Pope has been retained by the Town of Oyster Bay for a project to improve pedestrian walkability, accessibility and safety in the heavily congested downtown Syosset commercial area. Project includes new pedestrian crosswalks and upgrade of existing pedestrian crossings; installation of decorative pavers at pedestrian crossings; creation of pedestrian safe havens; installation of decorative lighting; creation of green spaces through the planting of street trees and planters; replacement of large areas of concrete sidewalk with decorative paving stones and the installation of benches, trash receptacles & directional signage.
